Teacher Candidates at Illinois State University are expected to learn and exhibit professional dispositions suitable for classroom teachers, including: Collaboration, Honesty/Integrity, Respect, Reverence for Learning, Emotional Maturity, Reflection, Flexibility, and Responsibility.

In the event a candidate demonstrates a disregard for one or more of these competencies, they may receive a Disposition Concern. Disposition Concerns are intended to be learning opportunities for candidates' growth and not punitive. As such they may be written as Resolvable or Unresolvable. However, three (3) Unresolvable Disposition Concerns will lead to removal of the candidate from their given teacher preparation program.
